I. INFORMATION CLAUSE

- 3, Personal data shall be processed by the Administrator in order to carry out current statutory and business activities, to execute contracts and to perform legal obligations incumbent on the Administrator.
- 4. Personal data will be processed only to the extent necessary to carry out the aforementioned tasks and kept for the period resulting from the legal obligation to keep records, including financial records, or until they are deleted as a result of the exercise of the relevant right by the data subject.
- 5. Personal data may be transferred to authorities supervising the Institute's activities, courts or other authorities (e.g., tax authorities or law enforcement agencies) and independent external advisors (e.g., auditors) or entities providing services, which results from the provisions of law or contracts to which the Administrator is a party, as well as external entities, under contracts signed with the Administrator for the entrustment of personal data processing.
